- Reduce Food Insecurity for Ohioans support food retailers and distribitors through Healthy Food for Ohio
- Criminal justice reform is critical to family and community stability
- Create Targeted Neighborhood Homeownership Development Program
- Enact pragmatic regulations around land installment contracts

Fortify Ohio's Small Businesses and Main Streets

- Offer zero/low interest, patient, risk-tolerant capital to local intermediaries. Expand existing state business development programs
- Establish the Job Creation Through Community Investment Program
- Improve the Ohio Historic Preservation Tax Credit to support rural Ohio

- All newly created programs should require training for the release of funds
